First, let me wish all of you happy holidays and best wishes for 2014. Hire Heroes USA is finishing 2013 at the same relentless pace as we began. We set a goal of 600 veterans hired with our assistance this year, and we were able to surpass it in November. In addition to the 600 plus veterans



that have found careers, hundreds more have been helped by our staff. In recognition of this team's hard work and results, we have recently received grants of: \$50K from Continuum and \$550K from Altria. Also, we have renewed our partnership with the WWE, which gives us \$120k to help veterans, and tremendous exposure through their global brand. Our new PSA will air on the WWE's "Tribute to the Troops" show on December 28th at 9PM EST on NBC. Currently, the National Coalition of 7-Eleven Franchisees is running a point of purchase campaign that will bring in an expected \$645K to Hire Heroes USA. 
